Klein Family Learning Center to benefit from special Derby gift shop

The [Klein Family Learning Center](#) will open a temporary gift shop on the backside of Churchill Downs during Derby Week, April 28 to May 5.

Proceeds from sales at the shop will benefit the Klein center, which provides English-as-a-second-language and other enrichment and self-help courses for members of the Hispanic community working on Churchill's backside.

"We hope that horsemen take this opportunity to purchase their Derby gear through us," Jennifer Hoert, director of the Klein center, said in a news release. "If they purchase [the] product from the Learning Center gift shop, they benefit in two ways; they get great souvenirs and they are supporting the educational programs on the backside."

The shop will be open from 7 a.m. until 30 min after the post time of the last race each day, except on Monday, April 30, when it will be open from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
