# **Klein Center starts construction on expansion**

## **Business First of Louisville**

The Klein Family Learning Center, a nonprofit initiative of the Kentucky Derby Museum that provides educational opportunities to Churchill Downs' backside employees, began construction on an expansion of its learning facility today.

The center is adding 800 square feet and two classrooms to its existing library and two classrooms. Fifteen local contractors have teamed up to provide labor and materials valued at \$160,000 for the project, according to a news release.

Since opening in 2002, the center has helped more than 1,000 people in language skills, citizenship, computer skills, art and other areas. Volunteers develop and teach the majority of the classes, and most courses are offered at no charge.
